The 1981 Supplementary Appropriation (No 2) Act
1981 - No. 6 of 1981

1. This Act may be cited as the 1981 Supplementary Appropriation (No 2) Act 1981.
2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of one million seven hundred and seventy-five thousand and nine hundred and fifty-seven dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1981.
3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads specified, and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the Schedule.
