

AN ACT To provide for the Prescription of Ministers by Parliament.

Short title
and commence-
ment.

1. This Act may be cited as the Prescription of Ministers Act, 1993, and shall come into force on such date as the Minister may appoint, by notice published in the Gazette.

Prescription

2. For the purposes of section 33(2) of the Constitution the prescribed number of Ministers (in addition to the Prime Minister) shall not exceed eighteen.

3. The Prescription of Ministers Act (No. 2) of 1981 is hereby repealed.
