THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (EXPORT TARIFF CLASSIFICATION FOR ROUND LOGS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2011

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 7 of the Customs and Excise Act, I, **GORDON DARCY LILO**, Minister of Finance and Treasury, do hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Export Tariff) (Amendment) Order 2010 and shall come into effect on 1st January 2011 and expires on the 30th June, 2011.
2. The export duty rate payable on the export of round logs shall be calculated and determined in the manner provided in the schedule herewith.

 - (c) by deleting the duty rates of “\$1.25 per stick which appears in respect of tariff items “2402.2010”, “2402.2020”, “2402.9000” and substituting there for the duty rate “\$1.28” per stick.
 - (d) By deleting the duty rates of “\$396.00” per kg which appears in respect of tariff item “2403.1010” and substituting there for the duty rate “\$405.90 per kg.
 - (e) By deleting the duty rate of “\$660.00” per kg which appears in respect of tariff items “2403.1090”, “2403.9100”, “2403.0090” and substituting there for the duty rate “\$676.50” per kg.

(Cap. 161)****THE LEVY OF RATES AND DUES****(PORTS OF HONIARA AND NORO) RULES 2010**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 72 of the Ports Act and with the approval of the Minister, the Authority hereby makes the following Rules:-

1. These Rules may be cited as the Levy of Rates and Dues (Ports of Honiara and Noro) Rules 2010 and shall come into force on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.
2. The rates and dues set out on the Schedules shall be levied by or paid to the Authority in respect of the various matters specified in it, when the work or appliances so specified are provided or the services so specified are provided at the Ports of Honiara and Noro.
3. Notwithstanding anything in these Rules it shall be lawful for the Authority to enter into any special agreement in respect of any matter in accordance with the charges specified on the Schedules of Rates and Dues hereto.
4. The levy of Rates and Dues (Ports of Honiara and Noro) Rules 2006 (Legal Notice 154 of 2007) hereby revoked.

**SCHEDULE OF DUES AND RATES
