1. This Act may be cited as the 2008 Supplementary Appropriation (No.2) Act 2008 and is deemed to have come into effect on the date it is assented to by the Governor General.

- **2.** (1) The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of twenty-seven million three hundred and ninety thousand seven hundred and two dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2008.
  - (2) The sum specified in subsection (1) shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the commencement of this Act under section 1 for supply for the heads specified and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto in the Schedule.
